

Assistive Technology for Children Program

The Disability Resource Center will purchase an assistive technology device for children with disabilities, up to \$500.

Guidelines

- The program is for children with disabilities up to age 23.
- A letter on letterhead is required from a medical physician, physical, occupational, or speech therapist that explains how the device will benefit the child.
- The child's parent or guardian needs to volunteer (5) five hours OR a
 donation of \$50.00 is required to help support the Assistive Technology for
 Children Program.
 - ❖ Volunteer opportunities include helping at the Center with mailings, peer mentoring, filing, setting up files and folders, setting up new packets of information, etc. Volunteer opportunities also include helping with fundraisers. Making phone calls, invitation mailings, attending the fundraisers and helping out where needed.
- The volunteer hours need to be completed before the device is ordered. If a donation of \$50.00 is preferred, it needs to be collected before the device is ordered.
